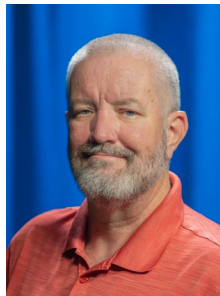




Pursuing Ethical Procurement
