In accordance with the NPI Constitution and Bylaws, the governing body of NPI consists of six Officers and six Directors. The six Officers are the Immediate Past President, President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary and AEP Officer. Each Officer serves for a one-year term. Each Director serves a two-year term. Directors

The Board of Directors oversees the management of the property, affairs, activities, and business of NPI. It establishes policies within the limits specified in the NPI Constitution and Bylaws. Serving on the Board is a worthwhile and rewarding experience for members professionally and is vital to the governance of NPI. All members of the Board are expected to attend the monthly Board conference calls, as well as attend the Spring and Fall Board Meetings and the NPI Annual Conference.

Candidates for any Officer or Director Position must have been a member in good standing for at least one year immediately preceding the election. Candidates for the office of Secretary must have served at least one year on the Board of NPI. Members whose employers are not public agencies may serve on the Board provided that such person does not solicit business on behalf of such person or his or her employer during any NPI activity.

The nominee for Secretary must have served at least one year on the NPI Board of Directors. Eligible nominees from the NPI Board of directors are:

The Nominating Committee anticipates announcing the election results on or before August 15, 2022. Newly elected Officers and Directors will be installed at the in-person conference in Atlanta in October 2022.
